



## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The checklist below will help you prepare to complete the SFGRF scholarship application process. This checklist is not meant to be all inclusive but does give you a chance to start collecting the necessary information so you are prepared when the application opens.

- Official High School Transcripts**
- Official College Transcripts (if you have taken college-level classes)**
- ACT/SAT Scores (if taken)**  
Optional
- College Choices**
- Activities for Grades 11 and 12**  
Examples include: service organizations, special interest groups, church groups, social organizations, sports, etc. Please include: Name of organization/activity, type of participation, dates of participation, offices held. Please limit to one page.
- Employment for Grades 11 and 12**  
Include holiday, summer, casual or temporary jobs. List the most recent job first. Please limit to one page.
- Letters of Recommendation**  
From individuals who know you well and can give specific details/insights into who you are. It is mandatory that one letter be academic (teacher).
  - Academic**
  - Other**
- Parent/Guardian contact**  
Name, address, e-mail, and phone number
- Parent/Guardian Marital Status**
- Parent/Guardian Employment**  
Occupation and employer
- Parent/Guardian Income**  
Annual estimated income, other income (and source), total estimated income, and combined total estimated income.
- Information from a completed FAFSA**
  - Student Aid Report (SAR)**
  - Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)**
- Be prepared to write two, one-page essays. Topics will be revealed when application opens 12/15/2021.**



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
